Security Level 3:

The Child is getting the same level of attention as all other unaccompanied children.

Observations like on all other minors.

Observations can result in decision to implement security level 1 or 2

If the child disappears, standard procedures for missing unaccompanied minors are being followed.



Security Level 2:
The child is getting extra attention by the staff.

The Child is being checked up on 6 times a day to make sure he/she is still there.

According to the Danish Social services act § 108 section 2. The Child and youth committee of the municipal council can decide to surveille the communication of the child.

If the child does not make it to school the teacher will contact the camp. Procedures on contacting the police is then followed.

A (professional) Legal Guardian is being assigned to the child.

If the Child disappears, it is being reported to the local police immediately. Picture, description and other relevant information of the child is faxed and E- mailed to them



Security Level 1:

The Child is under konstant surveillance – with respect of privacy.

According to the Danish social services act § 108 section 2. The Child and youth committee of the municipal council can decide to surveille the communication of the child.

In cooperation with the municipal council and if necessary the police, A special effort, is made by having ekstra round the clock staff, with the purpose of securing that the child does not disappear.

The municipal council can choose to place the child at a different location outside the asylum camp. (open or closed institution)

A Professional Legal Guardian is being assigned to the child.

If the Child disappear it is being reported to the local police immediately. Picture, description and other relevant information of the child is faxed and E- mailed to them





- Is it ok to place trafficked children in closed institutions against the will of the child, to prevent them from further harm?
- When a 17 year old minor is found in crime, in order to support his poverty stricken family, is it then a cultural difference, parental neglect or human trafficking?

2009 Opgørelser over sager med potentielt handlede børn

48 sager blev i 2009 udredt.

Følgende vurderinger blev taget heraf:

- 5 sager med stærke og flere indikatorer på menneskehandel
- 1 sag med stærk mistanke og få indikatorer
- 16 sager med forskellige grader af mistanke om menneskehandel og få indikatorer
- 7 sager har der ikke været nogen umiddelbar mistanke, men kunne ikke vurderes
- 19 sager var barnet vurderet ikke handlet.
- 5 sager blev forelagt udlændingesservice
- Udlændingesservice vurderede at 2 børn var ofre for menneskehandel.
